

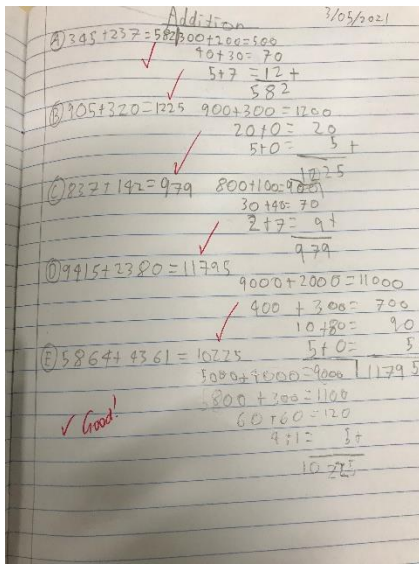
It has been a great start to the year in 4M!

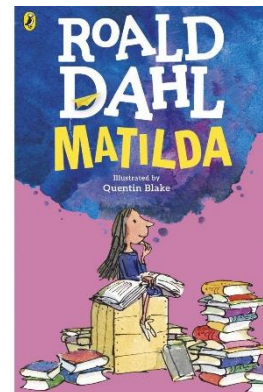
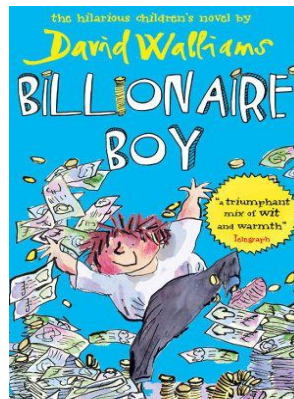
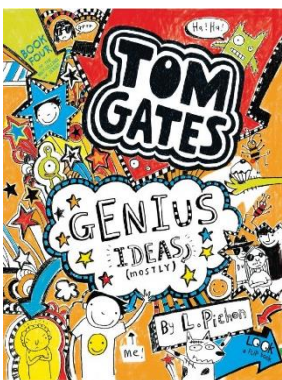
The numbers on the first two cards add to 15. ✓

Many of us are enjoying some of the books below:

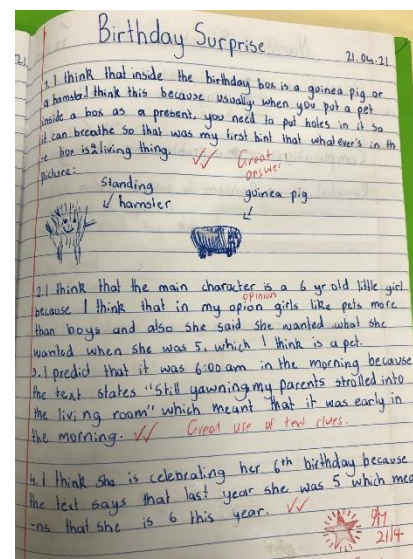
