

YEAR 4 ROYAL NATIONAL PARK 2022



Dear parents and carers

An excursion to the Royal National Park has been organised for Stage 2. This excursion will provide students with experiences that support the Science topic 'Earth's Changing Surface'. The students will walk across an ancient landscape to observe evidence of weathering and erosion with a backdrop of stunning coastal views and cliffs. They will participate in hands-on activities at Wattamolla and along a bushwalk on the upgraded Coast Track.

Date: Friday 14 October 2022 **Where:** Royal National Park

Time: Students will depart from school at 8:45am and return by 3:00pm. Travel will be by bus.

Students must be at school no later than 8:15am.

Cost: \$30

All students must wear their school uniform, comfortable enclosed shoes, and a school hat. Students will need to bring recess, lunch, and water in their school bag (no cans or glass bottles).

Please note that the excursion will go ahead even if it rains. Students are encouraged to bring a raincoat.

Students will be accompanied by Year 4 teachers and support staff. The staff members with CPR training are Ms Macri, Ms Petrovska, Ms Isaac, Ms Kallu and Ms Boyd.

As part of our COVID-19 smart measures, mask wearing is strongly encouraged for all students on the bus.
