

DROP OFF AND PICK UP – Term 1 2022

Dear parents and carers

DROP OFF AND PICK UP: We will be reinstating the drop off and pick up school routine that was employed in 2021.

We ask that parents/carers work with us – no adults are allowed on-site at this time.

Drop Offs: are straight forward. On arrival from as close to 8:45am as possible, students come in via the gate they normally enter the school from, sanitise their hands and go straight to their classroom.

On **Tuesday 1 February** your child will be directed from the school gate to a playground area where an executive member will show them to their 2022 class.

Pick Ups from **2.20-3.00pm**, all gates will be supervised by staff. Students will be leaving school in house groups as per 2021 and as they did earlier this year, via the gate they entered, which you will need to discuss with your child, so they know exactly where to meet you.
