NAIDOC week






This term, we also enjoyed dressing up as our favourite book character for Book Week Dress Up Day. Check out some of our costumes below!

You can access books online while at home. This will be excellent to use during the school holidays. Please follow the instructions below.


How to access eBooks and audio books from home:

There are three options for you to choose:


Option 1. Log into Oliver/orbit

You can search for any book title in the search bar also.




