Enter your child's details, select the tests you would like to purchase and then proceed to payment. Online parent payment closes Monday, 28 July 2025.

IMPORTANT: Please enter your child's name accurately into the system as it will appear on their ICAS certificate. No cash payments will be accepted. The **tests will be held <u>before school</u> from 8:00am** so be aware that you will need to bring your child to school early on the day of the test.

Privacy Collection Statement

The following information is a privacy notification about how your child's data is kept private and secure.
