




I need to have a test.

This will be a hospital or another building.










If I don't have the test in my car I will go into a room in a building.

I will need to wait my turn. I will wait in the car or inside the room.






Next is my turn. The person testing me will be wearing a special gown and gloves, as well as a mask.

I might also hold and squeeze something when I have the test




This may feel tickly and uncomfortable.


You may feel like you have to cough or sneeze








It will be over quickly the test is quicker than the time it takes to tie your shoe laces
