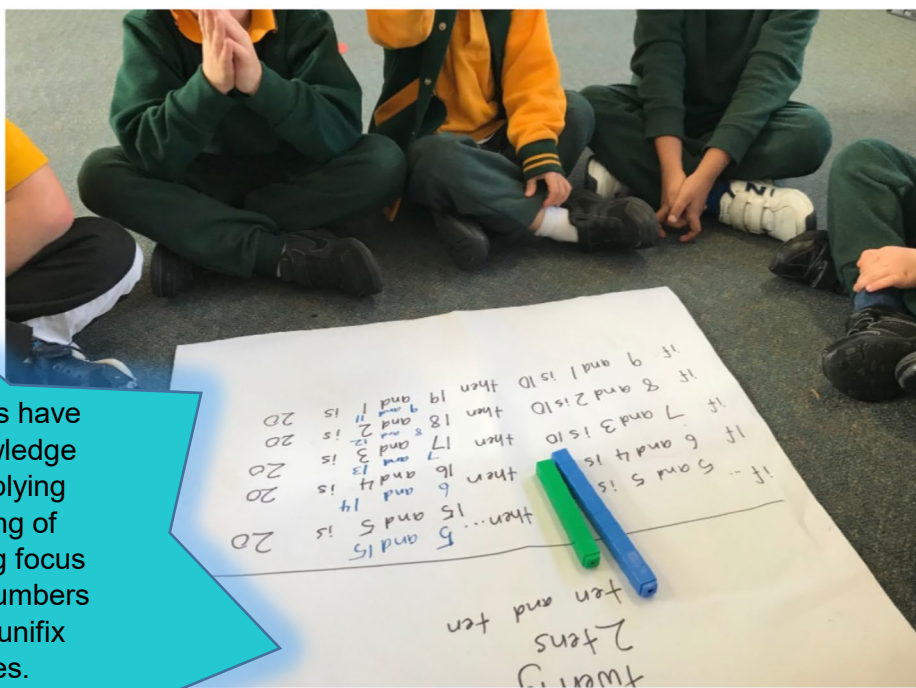


Term 2 in KT
